## SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are funds that do not have to be repaid and are usually based on academic merit but can be based on a student's interests, hobbies, religion, ethnicity, and/or financial need. The following scholarships will be awarded in the Spring and/or Summer semester for the upcoming Fall academic year. Awarded amounts will be equally divided between Fall and Spring semesters, unless otherwise noted.

### INTERNAL SCHOLARSHIPS

#### ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

- For High School students
- Based on GPA
- ACT=20
- Excludes Developmental Education/ESL in 12 hours
- \$2,800

#### HONORS SCHOLARSHIP

- For High School students
- GPA=3.08
- Minimum ACT score of 22
- Excludes Developmental Education/ESL in 12 hours
- Full tuition and fees

#### LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

- For High School students
- Must show leadership experience
- Excludes Developmental Education/ESL in 12 hours
- \$392.00 per semester

#### ADULT SCHOLARSHIP

- For new adult learner
- Outstanding work performance/no prior college experience
- Includes Developmental Education/ESL
- Amount varies

## INTERNAL SCHOLARSHIPS (cont.)

### 5 FOR 6 SCHOLARSHIP

- Enrolled in WorkReady U or other Adult Basic Education program
- Have NOT received federal financial aid in the past
- Do NOT currently qualify for federal financial aid
- Have NOT earned an Ability to Benefit (ATB) qualifying score on the ACCUPLACER

### AMARILLO COLLEGE

- Full time Student
- Student must demonstrate financial need
- GPA: 2.75
- Award amount varies

### ASSOCIATE OF MATHEMATICS/SCIENCE/TRANSFER GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

- Funded by Susan Santolucito
- Created to support students of exceptional promise in the fields of science and math who will continue their studies at a four-year institution.
- Have overall GPA of 3.2 or above
- Have a STEM GPA of 3.5 or above
- Plan to enroll in a bachelor's degree program at an accredited higher education institution
- Provide two references (instructors or employers)
- Provide proof of acceptance or class schedule for term to a four-year university
- Submit completed app
- Submit a typed, double-spaced essay (750-1000 words)

### BARBARA ROSE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

- For Continuing Students
- 2.50 GPA
- Music majors (Piano)
- Amount Varies

### BRIAN FAZEKAS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

- Enrolled in Delgado's Registered Nursing (RN) Program- AS-NURS
- Possess a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Enrolled in minimum of 7 credit course hours
- Possess unmet financial need (as determined by the financial aid department)

**Applicants must submit a recommendation letter from a clinical instructor (full-time or adjunct) who can comment on the applicant's:**

- Academic proficiency
- Commitment to excellence in clinical practice
- Level of caring and compassion
- Willingness to give to themselves to others
- Annual amount varies

**CAFÉ RECONCILE**

- For Café Reconcile Students enrolled in Culinary Program
- Café Reconcile chooses recipients
- Amount varies year to year

**CHANCELLOR SCHOLARSHIP (BOOK VOUCHER)**

- Minimum 2.0 GPA
- Amount: as determined by the Chancellor

**CULINARY SCHOLARSHIP-GAP/ROAST/ROTISSEURS**

- For students majoring in Culinary Arts
- Minimum 2.0 GPA
- Amount: \$250--two scholarships are awarded each application period (Spring and Fall)

**DELGADO ACHIEVEMENT FUND**

- For new and continuing students
- Minimum GPA of 2.0
- Amount varies annually

**FIFTH DISTRICT SAVINGS**

- Business or Accounting Major
- Internship with bank
- \$1,000/semester while employed at bank

**FORD SCHOLARSHIP**

- Students must be enrolled in the Ford Scholarship and automotive program
- Ford Scholarship chooses their participants
- Amount varies

**FRY FAMILY LEADERSHIP**

- For continuing students
- Application requires written essay and recommendation letters
- Students must attend full-time, participate in a student organization
- Demonstrate financial need as determined by the financial aid department
- Participate in student organizations
- Must Maintain GPA of 3.0 and continuous enrollment
- 2,500.00 annual award

**FUNERAL PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIP**

- For Funeral Service Education majors
- Minimum 2.0 GPA
- Will request how much and frequency

**GRAINGER TOOLS FOR TOMORROW SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

- For students pursuing a career in the skilled trades, public safety or supply chain
- Scholarship recipients receive tools after graduation
- \$2,000 awarded for tuition, fees, books and equipment

**HOSPITALITY**

- The scholarship is open to students majoring in Hospitality.
- To be eligible, students must have a 2.0 GPA
- Two awards of \$250 each application period (Spring and Fall)

**JACOBS TECH SCHOLARSHIP**

- For students in any Delgado technical program
- Minimum 2.0 GPA
- Amount Varies

**MELISSA DENO SCHOLARSHIP**

- Awarded to students professionally diagnosed with Dyslexia and ADHD
- Student must possess minimum of 24 credit hours earned
- Enrolled in minimum of 6 credit hours per semester
- Medical documentation of their diagnosis required
- Minimum 2.0 GPA

**METHODIST SCHOLARSHIP**

- Nursing student
- Has to live in certain geographical areas
- Criteria varies based on the Nursing departments' requirements

**MONICA SIMMS- ARROWHEAD MILLS-TODAY SHOW**

- Scholarship is only for Monica Simms
- If she is awarded the funds, they will be disbursed to her account accordingly
- Only covers cost of attendance and cannot be over awarded for a refund

**NEW ORLEANS DELTA FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP**

- Student must have completed 32 hours of coursework
- Student must have earned minimum of 2.7 GPA
- Submit a completed app
- Two (2) letters of recommendation
- Official transcript of coursework
- Essay of 250 words stating need for financial assistance
- Amount varies

**SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION OF NEW ORLEANS (SFNO)**

- Student must have completed 32 hours of coursework
- Minimum GPA of 2.7
- Two letters of recommendation
- Official transcript of coursework
- Essay of 250 words stating need for financial assistance
- Amount Varies

**SEYMOUR WEISS SCHOLARSHIP**

- Must possess minimum of 15 credit hours earned
- Minimum 3.5 GPA
- \$500 one-time award

**GAP**

- Loan to the student until their financial aid is applied to their account.
- No criteria
- Student must be in good academic standing with the school in order to receive funds

## SCHOLARSHIP CALENDAR FOR 2021-2022 AWARD YEAR

### **August 2021-September 2021**

- Open application period –Students complete application. Submit via online submission.

### **October 2021**

- Begin awarding early applicants as an enrollment incentive.

### **November 2021**

- Application deadline November 1, 2021. Delgado Scholarship Committee will receive a list of applicants shortly after the deadline to rate and score.

### **December 2021**

- Scholarship awards applied to recipients' accounts. All applicants are notified of their status by email.
- Authorize/disburse scholarships to recipients' accounts.
